Trading

Trading is strictly only to happen at the convention as the **hotel does not permit** room trading to respect the other guests that are staying at the venue.

Trading opens at **12:00pm** on the **21/09/2019** to the public and will close at **2:00pm** to the public. You are more than welcome to leave your table set up throughout the event.

Convention Ticket Holder Entry

Entry opens at **12.00pm** there are no tickets being sent out this year so please bring photo ID with you on the day to present at the door to collect your convention merchandise.

General Public Entry

Entry to the general public is open from **12:00pm until 2:00pm** there is a **\$5** entry fee for the general public kids under 12 are free. You will not receive any convention merchandise with general admission entry.

Cash Only.

Custom Competition

For those who are entering the custom competition can you please bring your cars in between 10.30am and 11.30am (please note if you bring them at this time and are not a trader you will NOT be allowed to stay on site and will be asked to leave until doors open at 12:00pm) or arrange to drop them off the night before so we can set this up for judging to happen while trading is in progress.

Hot Wheels Racing

Please bring all cars to the registration table with your first and last name written on the card (for **Stock** and **Faster than Ever**) or on a piece of paper so we can sticker them for the racing.

Please also remember that **Stock** and **faster than ever** have to be carded to be eligible to race. The racing will kick off around 2:00pm.

Little Racers (up to 5yrs): Little Racers classes will be run during the public entry period on a Super 6 lane track. It costs \$1.00 per car entered, unless the child has a full price convention ticket then it is included in the ticket price.

Each 6 car heat round winner will be placed on the winner's board. Each winner will be given a slip they can put their name and contact number on so we can then contact the overall winners of the class.

We can also invite them to watch the final runs for this class which will be held at **1.45pm**

You can use any stock car to race. There is no limitation to make or model. The car must remain stock though; no lubrication to the wheels at all or you will be disqualified. Cars must be entered in the original packaging.

Youth (6yrs to 15yrs): Youth classes will be run during the public entry period on a Super 6 lane track. It costs \$1.00 per car entered, unless the child has a full price convention ticket then it is included in the ticket price.

Each 6 car heat round winner will be placed on the winner's board. Each winner will be given a slip they can put their name and contact number on so we can then contact the overall winners of the class.

You can use any stock car to race. There is no limitation to make or model. The car must remain stock though; no lubrication to the wheels at all or you will be disqualified. Cars must be entered in the original packaging.

Stock: As the name says, you may choose any stock hot wheels car to race. There is no limitation to make or model. The car must remain stock though; no lubrication to the wheels at all or you will be disqualified. Cars must be entered in the original packaging..

Faster Than Ever: As the name says, you may choose any model hot wheels to race that came out with faster than ever wheels. There is no limitation to make or model. The car must remain stock though; no lubrication to the wheels at all or you will be disqualified. Cars can either be packaged or loose.

Modified: This class has a max weight limit of 100 grams. You may modify your car however you please but the body must remain attached to the stock chassis once modification has been completed. You can use whatever wheels and body you would like. Your car must not be any longer than 100mm, no taller than 50mm or any wider than the standard Orange Hot Wheels Track, 32.5mm wide. You can also use any dry lubricant you want in the wheels to

help it perform, but please make sure it doesn't run out and onto the track.

Super Hunt: You may choose any super treasure hunt car to race. There is no limitation to make or model. The car must remain stock though; no lubrication to the wheels at all or you will be disqualified.

Bingo

Bingo will be starting around **4:30pm** the bingo will be run by Richard Rowel. We will try fit as many rounds as we can before the **event closes at 5:30pm** for prize giving to follow.

Prize Giving

Prize giving will take place from **5:30pm** this is the opportunity for us to hand out the prizes for the custom competition and the hot wheels racing. There are trophies up for grabs for the custom competition for the first place getters. For the Hot wheels racing there are trophies for 1st 2nd and 3rd place getters in all categories.

Interval

This will be around **6:00pm** all attendees will have to leave the main hall and mix and mingle in the lobby for a short period to allow us to set up for the dinner this should take no longer than ½ an hour.

There is a cash bar in the lobby that people can buy drinks from **2:00pm** onwards.

Dinner + More

Entry to the dinner will be from **6.20pm** with dinner being served at **6:30pm** which consists of a buffet main course and desert – each dinner attendee will receive a complimentary drink with their dinner.

After dinner the rest of the night will consist of; bingo (with two complimentary rounds per dinner attendee), raffles and auctions. This part of the event will go until **late** with no set end time.
